We are also running a competition which involves children giving an award to the woman who impresses them the most. We have nominated a number of women and have made information available that can be used by entrants, however any woman can be chosen as long as she has close links to the district

There are two categories:-

**Children in Years 4 – 6**



1. Choose the woman whose story impresses you or excites you the most.
2. Briefly (2 -3 sentences) describe what she did.
3. What sort of woman do you think she was or is? Tell us **two** words that you think best describe her.
4. Design and produce an achievement certificate that you would like to present to her. On the certificate make it clear **why** you are awarding her this certificate.

**Children in Years 7 – 9**



1. Choose the woman whose story impresses you or excites you the most.
2. In a short paragraph describe what she did.
3. If you could interview her write at least **two questions** that you would like to ask her.
4. After reading about her, write the answers that you think she might give to these questions.
5. Provide the design for an appropriate achievement award that you would like to present to her.
6. Explain **why** you think she deserves this award.
